This practice offers a wide range of services, including preventative care, dentures, emergency treatment, gum care, high-tech procedures, oral surgery, cosmetic dentistry, root canals, tooth fillings, and teeth whitening. They are also a registered provider for ACC-related injuries and can assist patients with ACC dental registration. Additionally, they offer free comprehensive exams and consultations for Work and Income patients.

The vendor, a highly experienced dentist, dedicates an average of just 10 hours per week to this practice. In FY 2024, the clinic recorded a normalized EBITDA of \$104,750, compared to \$129,628 in 2023. Although it currently operates at low capacity, its prime location offers 3-4 times the potential for growth.
