Currently, the eatery specialises in fried chicken, bubble tea, and simple meal options. It generates a weekly revenue of \$9,000 (incl. GST), operating only 35 hours per week. A new owner could easily extend business hours to increase revenue.

The eatery features modern décor and well-maintained equipment, with 19 seats available. It is well-suited for set meals, casual dining, buffet-style offerings, Vietnamese pho, sandwiches, and more. The current owner lacks hospitality experience and has not fully explored the food options, leaving great potential for menu expansion.
